Year of the Word -- for kids

Two High Peak parishes are making sure that children are not left out in the Year of the Word. In addition to the initiatives taking place in local Catholic schools, the parishes of St Mary Crowned and All Saints in Glossop, a Derbyshire market town between Manchester and the Peak District, have set up scripture lending libraries for kids. Attractive baskets contain a wide range of Ladybird bible story books, and children are encouraged to take one home after Holy Mass and swap it for another when they've read it. "It's a delight to see children clutching the books as they leave the church, and I hope that parents, too, may discover afresh some of the treasures of scripture that their children may be discovering for the first time".
